2017	Australian ethics submissions and local Governance applications
2017-2019	STRIDER NZAus Childhood Outcome Study assessments conducted at 2.5 years corrected age
2020	Data analysis and results publication
	Trial sequential STRIDER IPD meta-analysis. Timing is determined by other trials in the Collaboration. It is expected that the UK and NZAus trials will complete childhood outcome assessments first.
