STRIDER NZAus Childhood Outcome Study Update

The Childhood Outcomes Study is well underway in New Zealand with 11 children seen and 3 more booked for assessment before Christmas. Parental response has been amazing, with 100% follow up of children at target age (2.5 years ± 6 months), and online questionnaires have been very well received. Neurodevelopmental outcomes have so far been very reassuring. The Childhood Outcomes Study will thus not only provide essential information about the long-term effects of antenatal sildenafil treatment, but will also provide important contemporary data on outcomes following severe, early fetal growth restriction.

Planning for follow-up at Australian sites is progressing well. We welcome all the paediatric investigators who have recently joined the STRIDER team and will be leading follow-up at each of the Australian sites. Ethical approvals are in place and locality agreements are underway.
